Generation Power CT offers emergency energy assistance to income-eligible households during (4) application cycles throughout the year. During GPCT's application cycles, qualifying households can apply for **one emergency energy assistance grant of up to \$500**. Households can qualify for assistance once per 12-month period.

For fuel grants: households can qualify for one future fuel delivery, up to \$500.

For utility grants: households can qualify for up to \$500 toward a past due balance.

Applications Cycles:

- **Application Cycle #1:** September 2-10, 2025
- **Application Cycle #2:** November 2-10, 2025
- **Application Cycle #3:** January 2-10, 2026
- **Application Cycle #4:** March 2-10, 2026

Eligibility Requirements:

- All emergency energy assistance programs allow households to **earn up to 75% SMI (State Median Income)**, based on gross income and household size.
- Households applying for GPCT's emergency energy assistance must provide proof of income for all adults in the household **over the age of 21**.
- Households applying for a deliverable fuel grant should **have less than ½ tank** and **provide a photo of their current fuel level**.
- Households applying for utility assistance must also provide a **past due bill in the name of a household member**, and **proof of making (4) payments in the preceding 12 months**.

Details:

- All decision letters will be **emailed only**.
- You can check your application status at any time by logging into the application portal.
- All applicants will be notified of the decision within 60 days. If you do not qualify or do not get approved in the application cycle you applied in and your circumstances have changed, you can reapply in the next application cycle.
